Dear Mr. Strelcheck:

At its April 3-6, 2023 meeting, the Gulf of Mexico Fishery Management Council (Council) voted to maintain the cooperative closure of the shrimp fishery off Texas (Texas Closure) for 2023. The Council's action extends the closure to all waters of the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) off Texas for the same period of time that the State of Texas closes the Texas Territorial Sea. The shrimp fishery is closed annually off Texas to allow shrimp to reach a larger and more valuable size prior to harvest.

With this letter, the Council respectfully requests that you implement the 2023 Texas Closure in accordance with the aforementioned action of the Council for the 2023 shrimp season off Texas.
