## Join us for a Public Hearing Call-in Session on Reef Fish Amendment 39 - Regional Management of Recreational Red Snapper

The Gulf of Mexico Fishery Management Council is hosting a call-in session **Thursday, August 1, 2013** beginning at **6:00 pm eastern time**. The purpose of the call is to solicit public comment on Reef Fish Amendment 39 - Regional Management for Recreational Red Snapper.

Regional Management of Recreational Red Snapper examines dividing the federal recreational red snapper quota among states or regions. This division would potentially give states/regions more flexibility in choosing seasons and bag limits, but would not necessarily result in more fishing days. Under regional management, red snapper would remain a federally managed species subject to federal conservation goals, and the Council would continue to oversee management of the stock.
