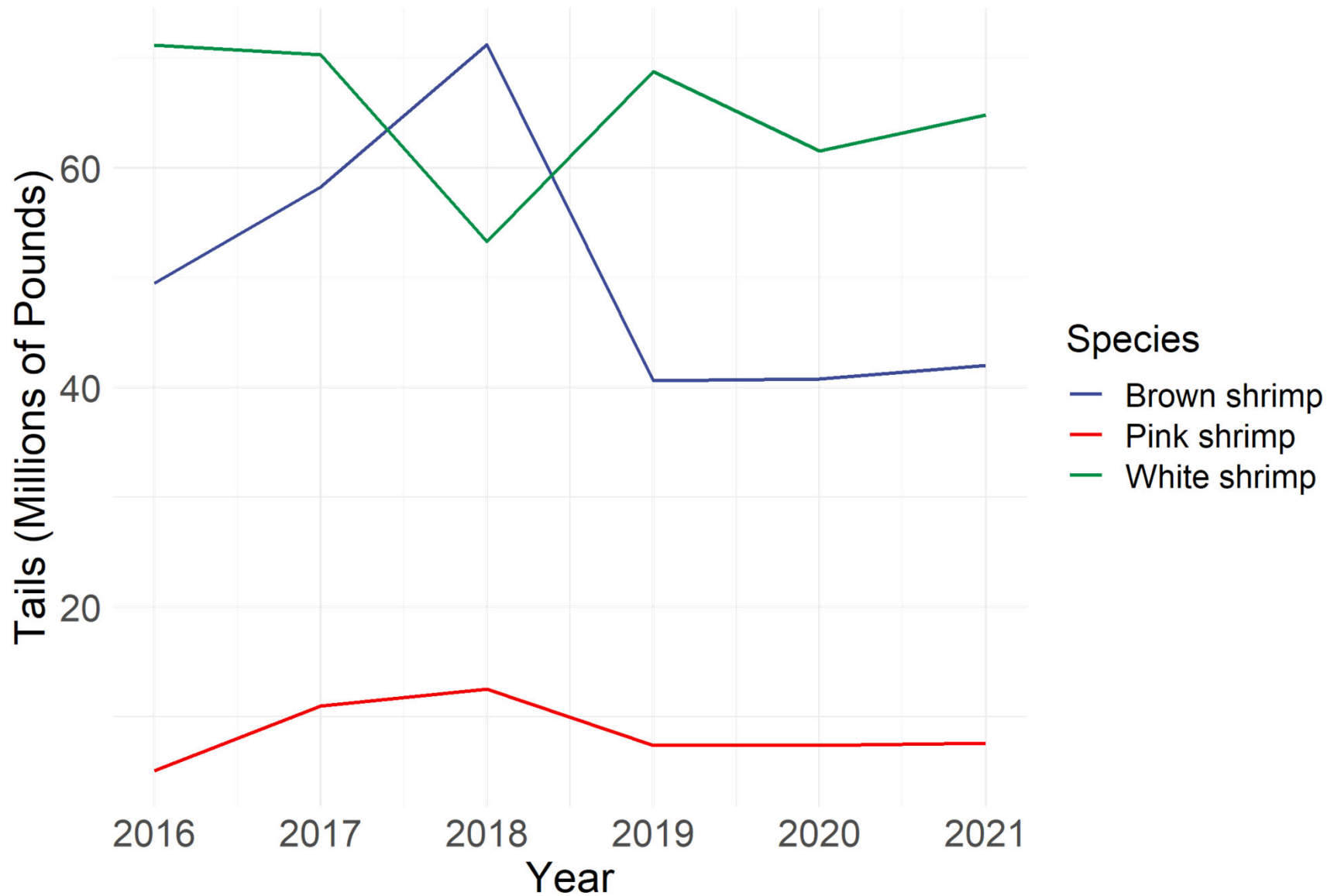

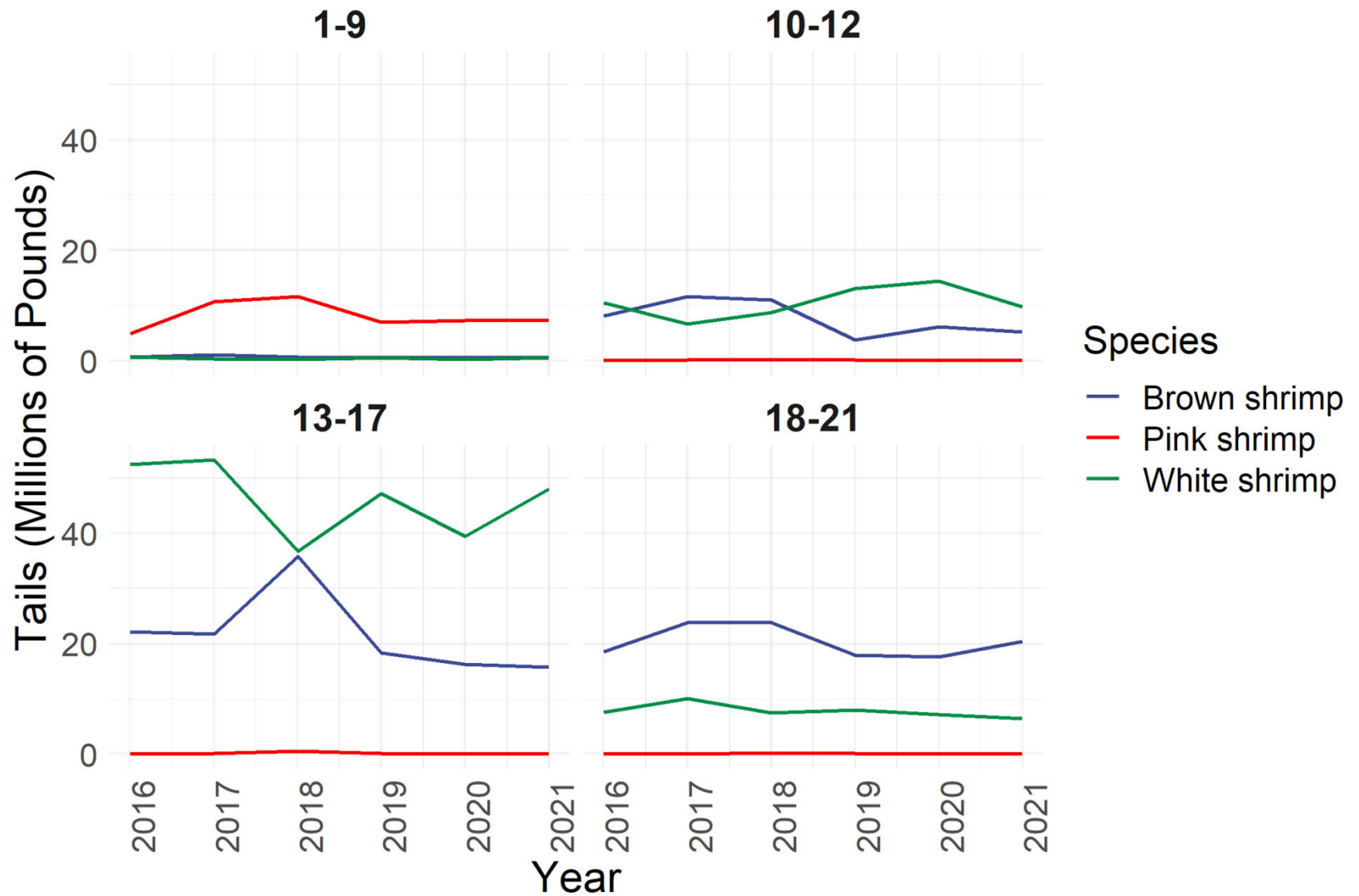

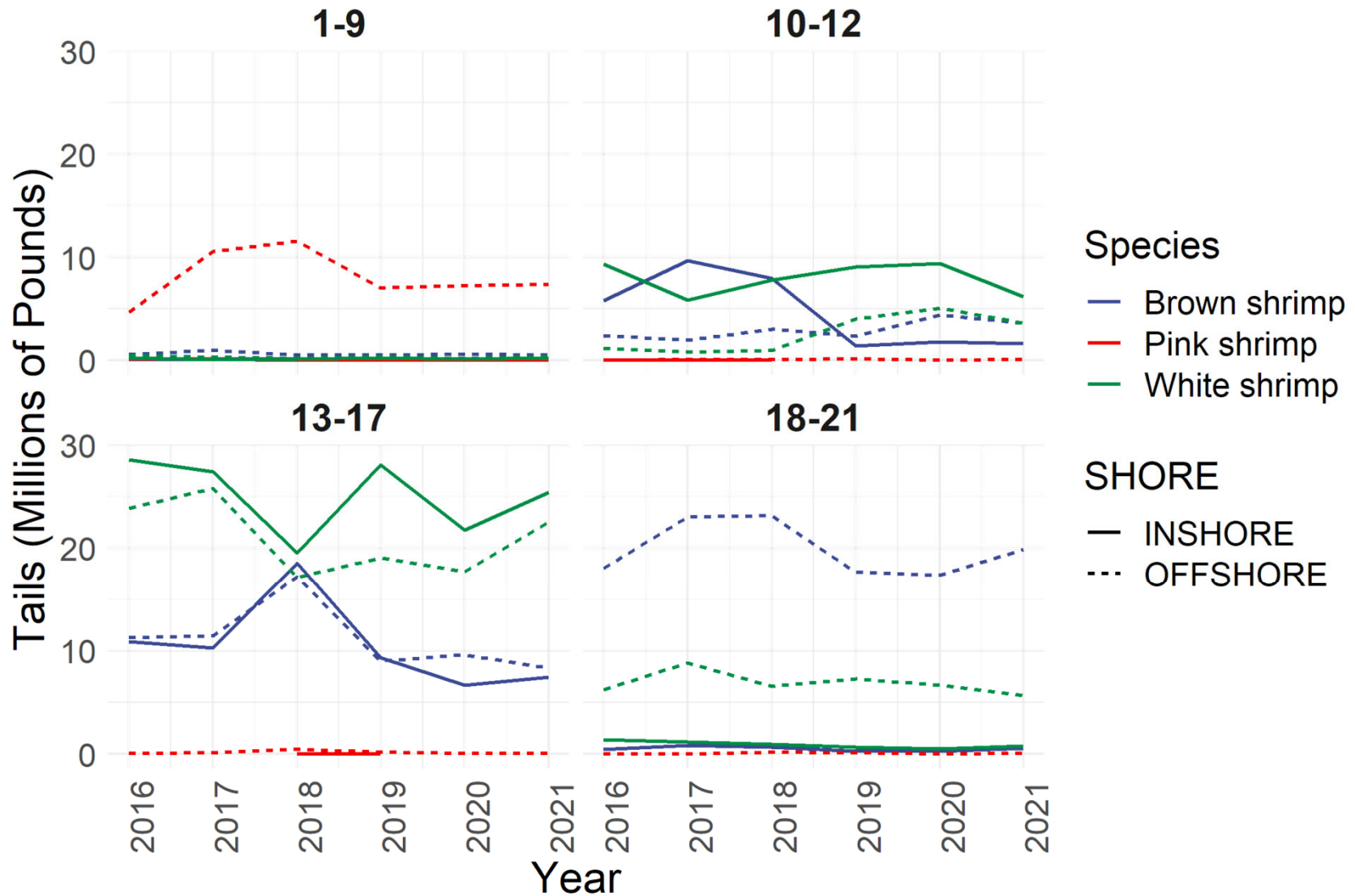
Total Landings, 2016-2021



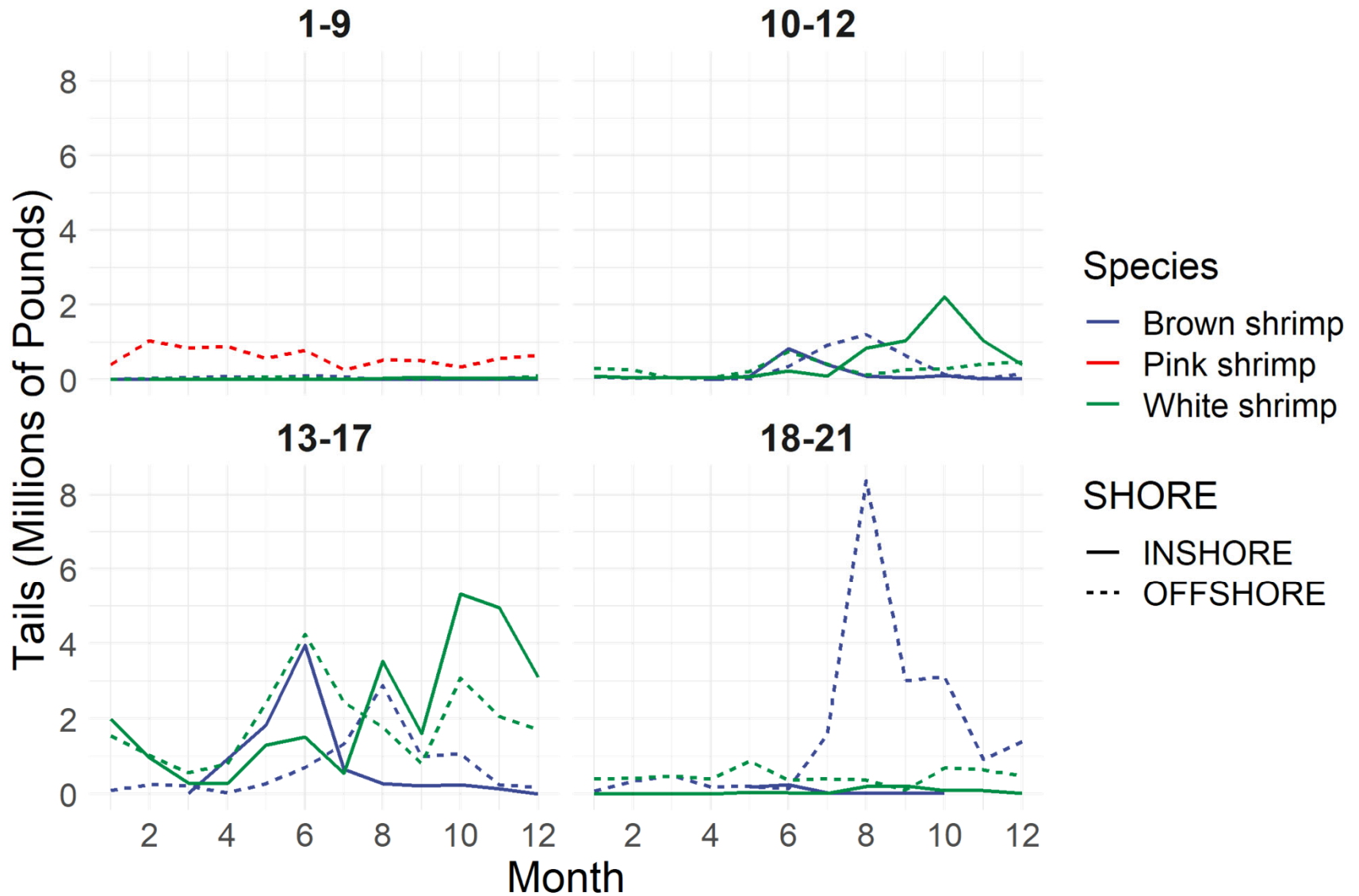
Total Landings by Area, 2016-2021



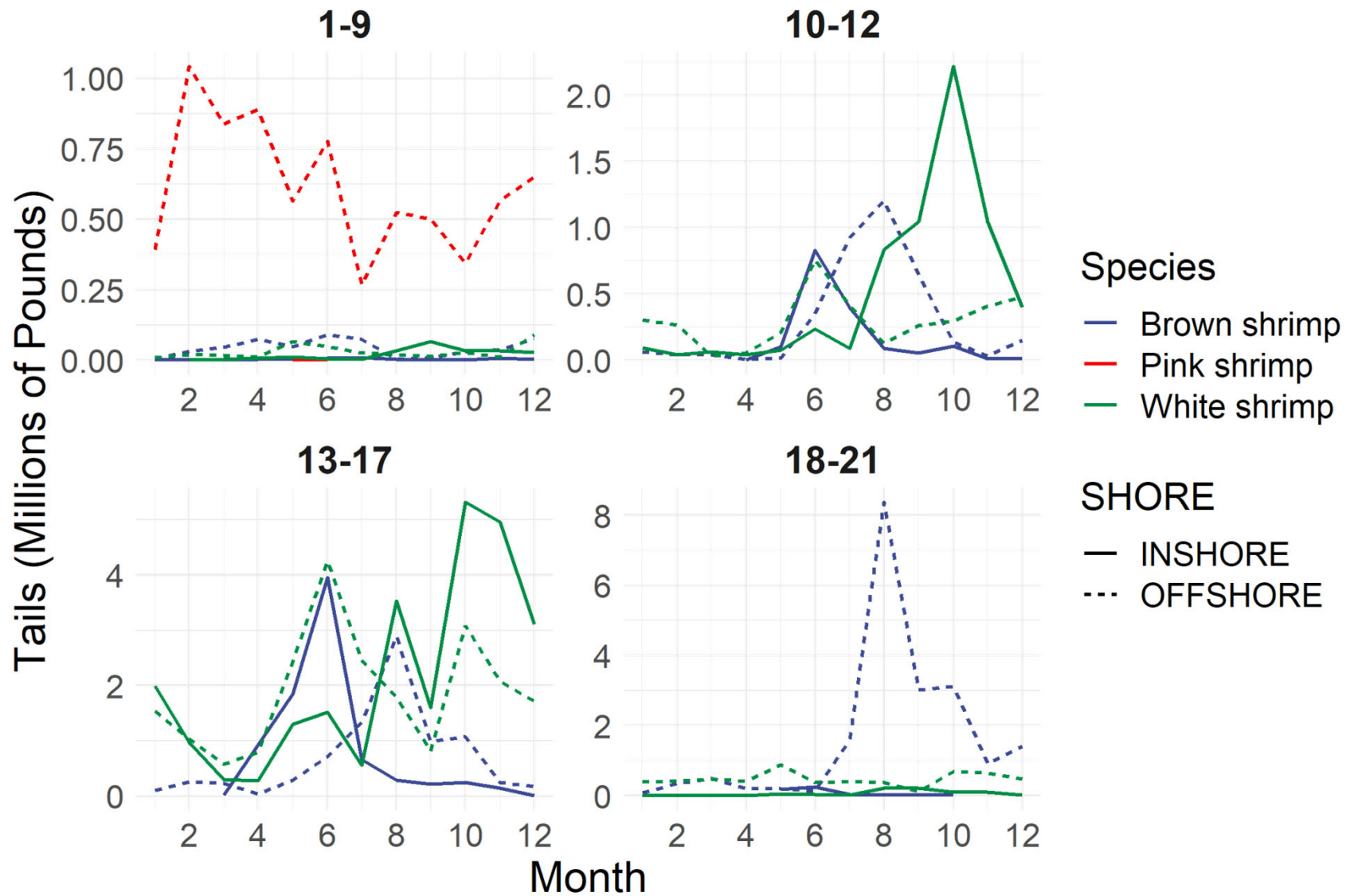
Total Landings by Area, Species, Shore, 2016-2021



2021 Monthly Landings by Area, Species, Shore



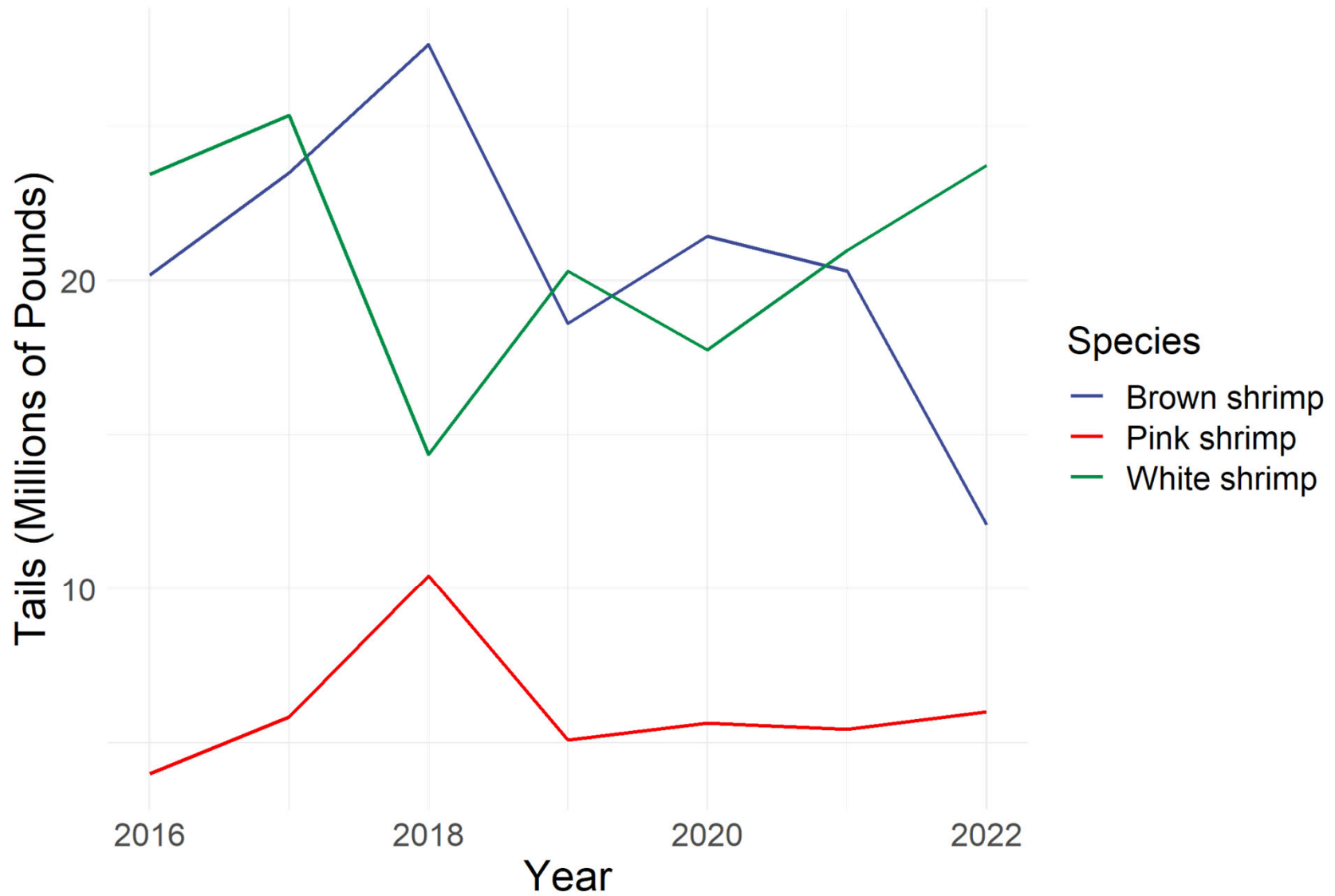
2021 Monthly Landings by Area, Species, Shore



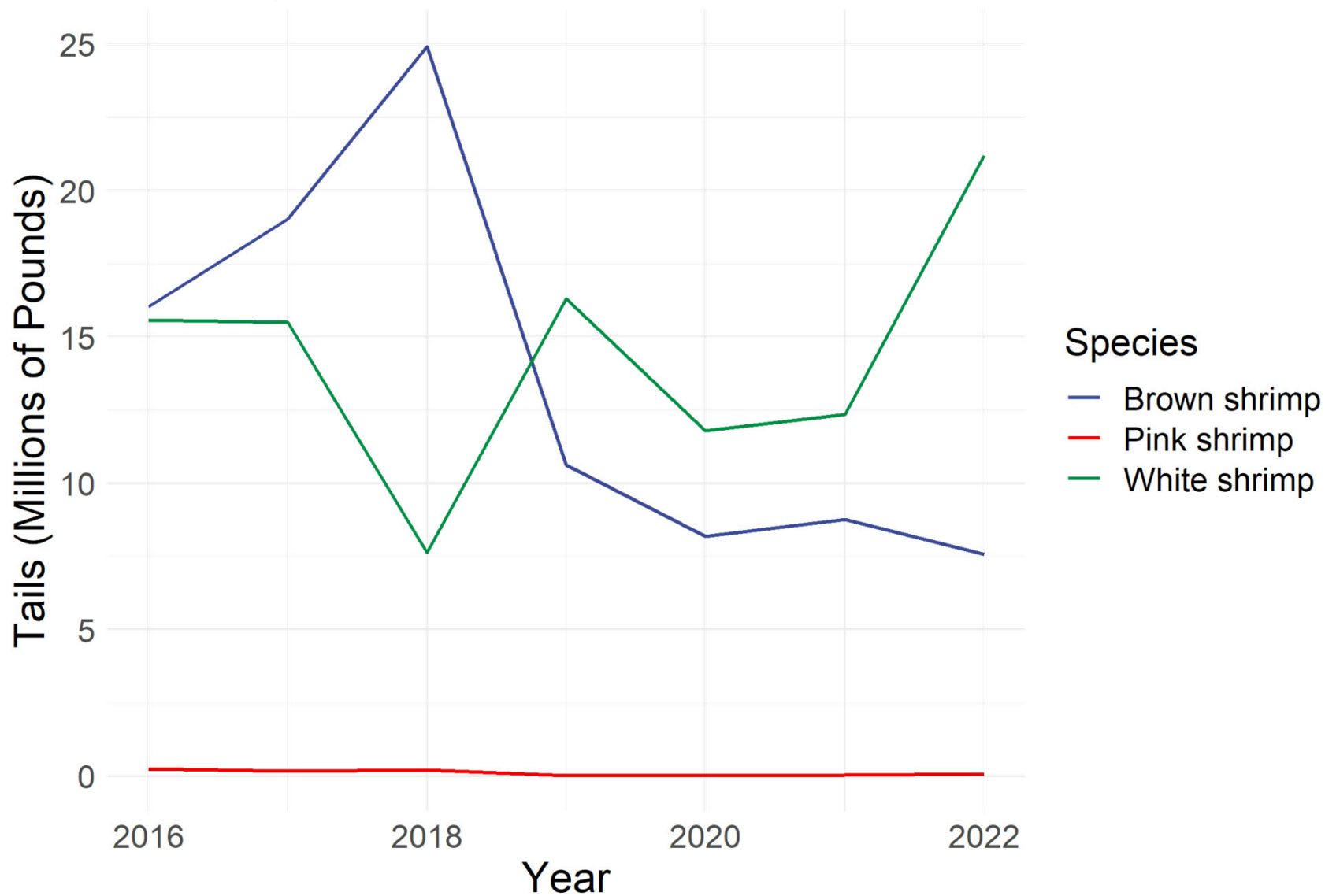

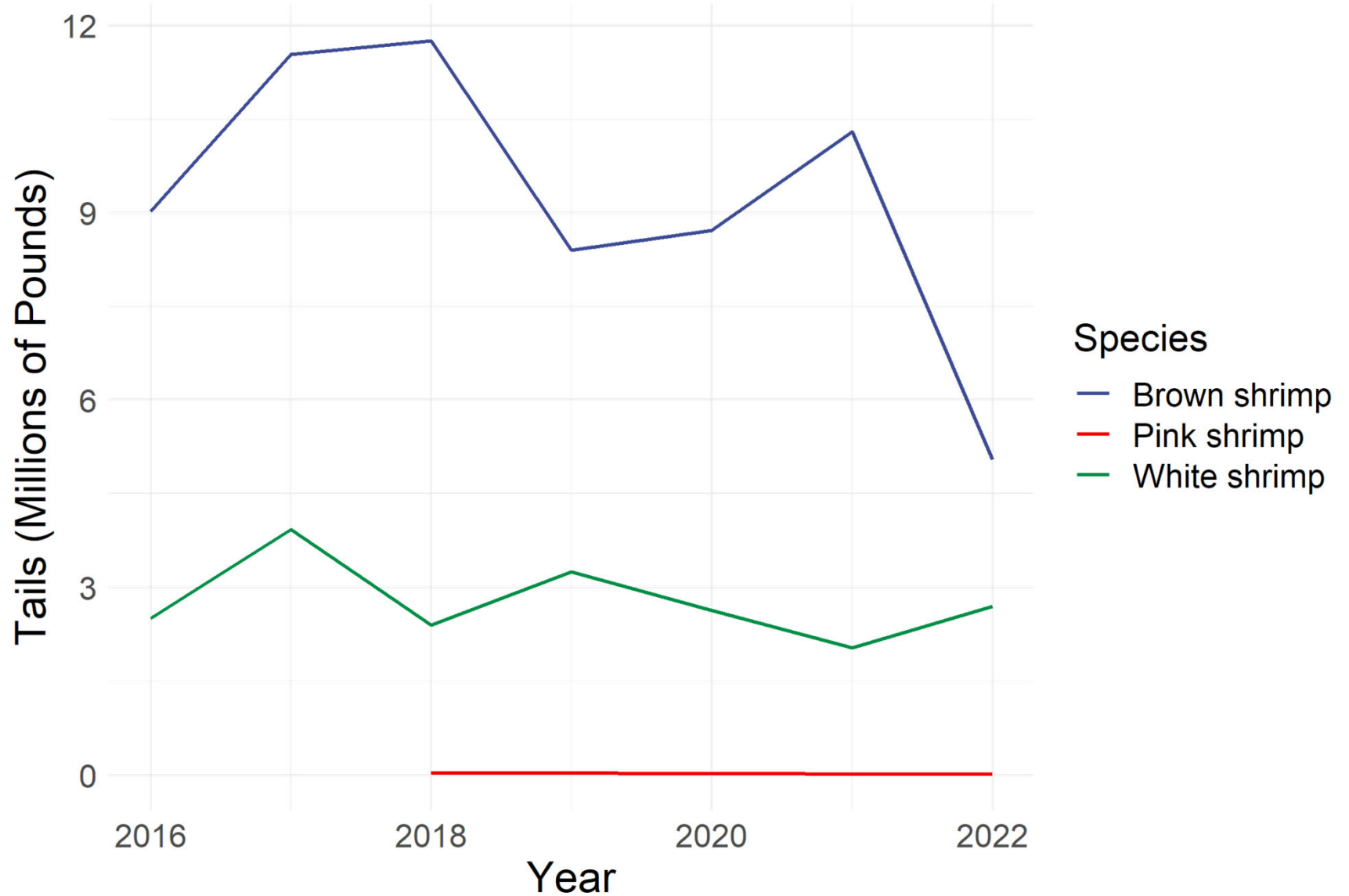
Jan-Aug Totals, Offshore



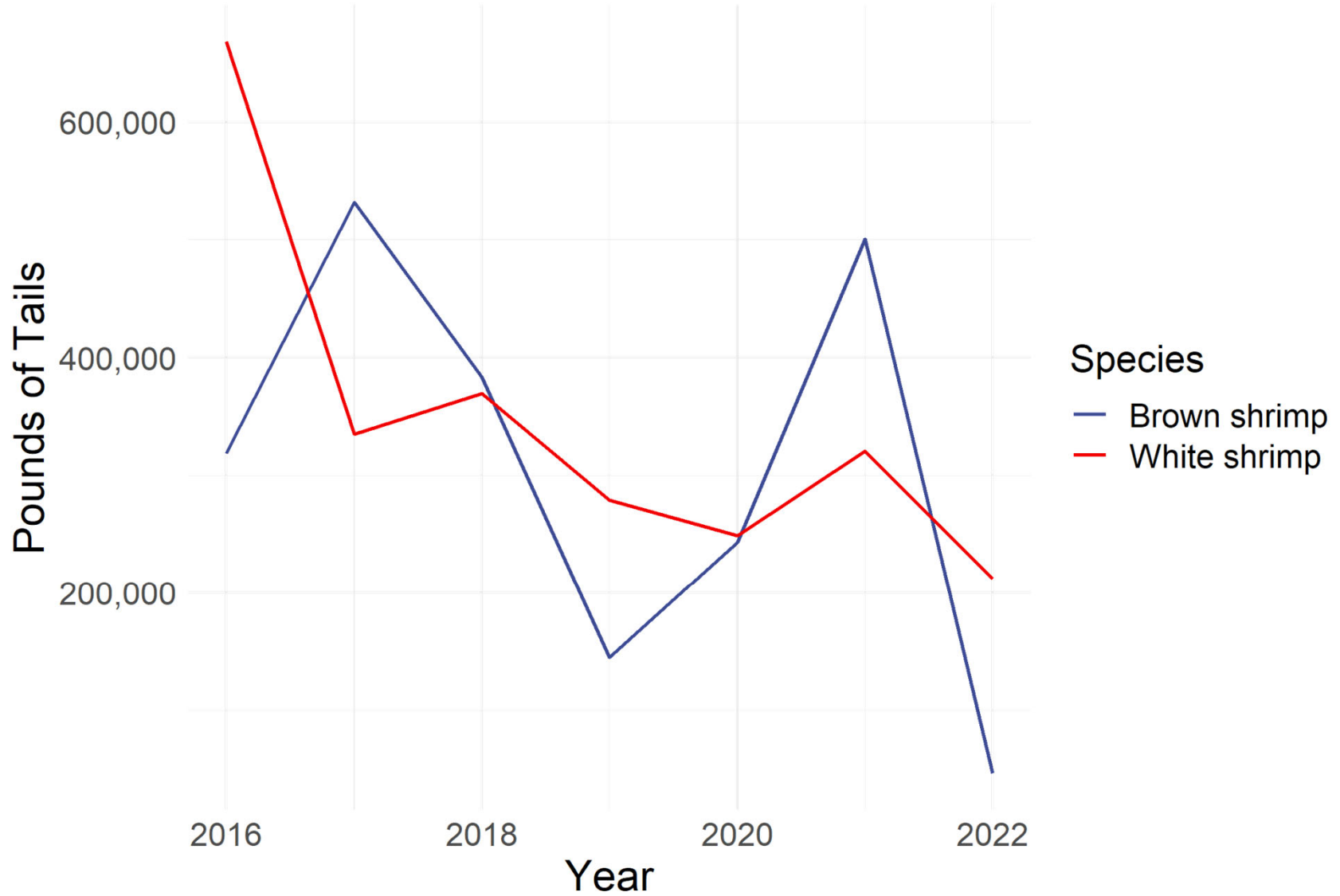
Jan-Aug Totals, Inshore

Summary: Shrimp Landings

- TX predominantly brown, LA white, FL pink
- Overall, most regions are predominantly inshore for all species with the exception of TX waters
