


Gulf of Mexico Red Grouper and Gag Recreational Landings







Gulf Red Grouper Recreational Fishing Regulations

- Closure Feb 1-Mar 31 deeper than 20 fathoms
- Minimum Size Limit: 20 inches TL
- Bag Limit: 2 red grouper
- Red grouper count towards combined 4 grouper bag limit
- 2023 Season: Jan 1-Jul 20 (projected in May using avg. 2021-22 landings)

MRIP Wave 4 (July/August) Red Grouper Landings Estimate

- 2023 Landings are preliminary at this time
- 99% of landings from MRIP
 - Private: 1,228,256 lbs gw, PSE = 48%
 - Charter: 115,221 lbs gw, PSE = 37%
- 1% from Headboat (8,663 lbs gw)
- No LA Creel or TX landings (not yet reported)





Review of Wave 4 Red Grouper Landings Estimate

- Reviewed by NMFS and FWC
- Investigated data for:
 - Outliers, non-representative interviews
 - Sample sizes
 - Differences in interview frequency (closed vs. open seasons)
- Majority of landings occurred early in wave (similar to 2022)
- 1,371 private boat intercepts
 - 240 intercepts of federal water trips
 - 19 trips intercepted for red grouper





Next Steps

- Continuing review to understand differences
 - Appear to be driven by effort and not dockside intercepts
- Landings finalized in spring
- SERO will project 2024 season
 - AM: no payback; manage to ACT
 - Projections use multiple years of data; estimates with high uncertainty may not be used for projections
- SEDAR 88 (Gulf Red Grouper) is considering SRFS in place of MRIP






Gulf Gag Grouper Recreational Fishing Regulations

- Closed Season January 1 to August 31
- Minimum Size Limit: 24 inches TL
- Bag Limit: 2 gag grouper
- Gag count towards combined 4 grouper bag limit
- 2023 season: September 1 to October 18

MRIP Wave 5 Gag Grouper Landings Estimate


- 99% of landings from MRIP
 - Private: 1,399,513 lbs gw, 42% PSE
 - Charter: 162,832 lbs gw, 33% PSE
 - Shore:106,602 lbs gw, 98% PSE
- 1% of landings from Headboat (8,644 lbs gw)
- No TX landings (not yet reported)





Review of Wave 5 Gag Grouper Landings Estimate


- Still undergoing review by NMFS and FWC
- MRIP-FES 7x higher than SRFS
 - Average difference 2020-2023 ~3x
- Intercepts
 - 1 shore, 15 private, 16 charter





Next Steps

- Complete review of landing estimates
- Investigating 2 highly influential APAIS intercepts
- Any changes would be available in February 2024
- Landings finalized in spring
- A56 approved: will monitor in SRFS in 2024+
- Determine overage
 - AM payback amount of ACL overage unless best scientific information available determines lesser, greater or no overage adjustment is necessary






Gulf of Mexico Red Grouper Cumulative Recreational Landings
