SEDAR 81 transitioned the recreational catch and effort data to the Marine Recreational Information Program's Fishing Effort Survey (MRIP-FES) and determined the stock was not overfished or undergoing overfishing as of 2021. The Committee should review draft Chapters 1 and 2 and provide feedback on the purpose and need, and range of actions and alternatives included in the document.
