## What is Fisherman Feedback?

A tool used to gather information on a fish stock from active fishermen on trends or unusual occurrences that scientists and managers may not have observed.

117 responses gathered from April 14 - May 19, 2023

Number of responses received in each of 21 areas in the Gulf. Respondents could select more than one area so the total number illustrated in the map ( $n=181$ ) exceeds the number of individual responses.

Number of responses related to stock condition sorted by fishing sector. Sector was self-selected by each respondent. Respondents were not limited to a singular sector declaration in their responses ( $n=101$ ). Comments that were not associated with the three primary fishing sectors were not analyzed.

## Stock Condition Related Response Sentiment
