SOUTHEAST REGION FEDERAL FOR-HIRE ELECTRONIC REPORTING AUGUST UPDATE



Actions since the June meeting

- ❖ July 8th - Cellular Based Vessel Monitoring System (VMS) Final Rule published
- ❖ July 21st - Gulf of Mexico (Gulf) Final Rule published
- ❖ July 21st - Office of Management and Budget approval of Data Collection (Paperwork Reduction Act [PRA])
- ❖ August 7th - South Atlantic Correction Notice published
- ❖ August 24th - Permit Holder Notification Letter to be mailed out

Phase 1 update

- ❖ Trip Declaration and Logbook reporting will be effective January 5, 2021 for Gulf Permitted Vessels, and January 4, 2021 for South Atlantic Vessels
 - Approval review of eTrips and VESL Software for use in For-Hire reporting is ongoing
 - Mississippi Department of Marine Resources has been provided technical specifications to see if Tails n Scales can be used for reporting

Phase 2 update

- ❖ The implementation date for the VMS requirements will be announced at a later date
 - Cellular and Satellite VMS systems with and without reporting forms are currently being tested
 - Several Approved Commercial VMS units are in the approval process for the For-Hire Fishery

Landing locations

- ❖ Approved landing locations and the landing location request form will be posted to the Southeast Electronic Reporting and Technologies Website soon
- ❖ When the Approved List is posted, if a vessel landing location is already on the approved list, the permit holder will not need to complete and submit the application form for approval

For-Hire Survey

- ❖ For-Hire Intercept Survey being developed
- ❖ Collaboration between SEFHIER team, Office of Science and Technology, Gulf States Commission is ongoing
- ❖ GULFIN award expanded to include Southeast For Hire Electronic Reporting Survey
 - State Coordination
 - Gulf Survey expected to start early 2021
- ❖ PRA public notice will publish in August and have a 60-day comment period
