Agenda Item IV: Coral Reef Conservation Program Update

Timeline Status: Presentation and information

Council input and next steps: Staff will present an update from the current Coral Reef Conservation Program grant. The Committee should provide feedback and suggestions on completed and ongoing tasks.

Agenda Item V: Flower Garden Banks National Marine Sanctuary Expansion Update

Timeline Status: Presentation and discussion

Council input and next steps: Mr. Schmahl will present a status update from the proposed expansion of the Flower Garden Banks National Marine Sanctuary and the timeline for the release of the rule package. The joint Shrimp AP, Coral AP, and Coral SSC were also presented with the proposed expansion and made recommendations that are included in the summary report from that meeting.

Agenda Item VII: Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary (FKNMS) Management Review

Timeline Status: Presentation and discussion

Council input and next steps: Ms. Sarah Fangman will present the Draft Environmental Impact Statement with the proposed alternatives, preferred alternatives, and proposed fishing regulations in the FKNMS. The proposed sanctuary expansion includes areas within the Council's jurisdiction. FKNMS staff presented this information at the joint Shrimp AP, Coral

AP, and Coral SSC; as well as the Reef Fish AP meetings. The APs and SSC comments have been included in the meeting summaries. Based on the recommendations of the SSC and APs, staff have prepared maps summarizing commercial reef fish activity and shrimp effort in the Florida Keys region including the FKNMS. The Committee is requested to review the materials and the APs and SSC recommendations, and provide direction to staff regarding comments on the FKNMS expansion so they can be forwarded in a letter. The Council has until January 31st, 2020 to provide comments.
