Interdictions	78	87	53	43
Red Snapper (lbs)	14,640	12,524	5,895	10,260

Comments:

- Personnel shortages have limited patrol hours and does not mean that there are fewer lanchas within our EEZ
- Assessing illegal Red Snapper catch is difficult
- Cutters routinely recover miles of illegal longline each patrol

Boardings	609	427
Significant Violations	26	10

- Most Common Violations:
 - Turtle Excluder Devices (TEDs)
 - By-Catch Reduction Devices (BRDs)
- 2024
 - Significant increase in 75/25 violations, specifically in the Houston/Galveston AOR
 - Continue to build partnerships with NOAA and State Law Enforcement agencies






