I have had a wide variety of experiences in fisheries economics and fisheries management, both in the US and internationally. A highlight of my career was service as the chief economist for the New Zealand Ministry of Fisheries. During that service, I launched an effort to restart a national recreational fishing survey which (after my service ended) resulted in substantially improved data on recreational fishing and catches. For 25 years, I was an academic economist at the University of Maine, with a research specialty in fisheries economics and fisheries management.
