## **Gulf Council Ad Hoc Red Snapper Charter For-Hire Advisory Panel to Meet in Tampa, Florida**

The Gulf of Mexico Fishery Management Council will convene its Red Snapper For-Hire Advisory Panel December 2-3, 2014, at the DoubleTree Tampa Airport Westshore hotel in Tampa, Florida. The meeting will begin at 9:00 am Tuesday and conclude by noon Wednesday.

The Panel is charged with making recommendations to the Council relative to the design and implementation of flexible measures for the management of red snapper for the for-hire sector. Some of the issues on the agenda include:

- Discussion of for-hire data collection
- Overview of management techniques in fisheries
- Review of the Headboat Collaborative pilot program
- Discussion of short- and long-term potential management measures
- Recommendations to the Council
